ROUTING HIGHLIGHTS:

Swakopmund - Etosha National Park – Windhoek
Etosha National Park, Private Lodge outside the Park, Lake Otjikoto + Okahandja

The Etosha National Park is a must for every visitor to Namibia. The dried out saltpan is the centre of the Etosha Park and the waterholes, both natural and man-made, attract thousands of animals. The scenery is unique and together with herds of antelope, zebra and big game such as elephant, rhino and lion give this beautiful game park its essential character.

ITINERARY:

**Day 1
Saturdays**

Depart Swakopmund northbound. A short stop at Okahandja or Otjibamba Lodge to join up with the guest coming from Windhoek. Continue via Outjo into Etosha National Park, where we undertake the first game drive in our touring vehicle. Just before sunset we will leave Etosha again and drive to our lodge/safari camp outside the Park.
DBB – privately owned lodge near Etosha Park – preferably Etosha Safari Camp

**Day 2
Sundays**

Day excursion into the Park. Except for the rainy season, Etosha's animals are dependant on artificial waterholes and natural springs. Explore the various waterholes along this enormous saltpan, which is called the "great white place of dry water" in a local language. Lunch stop at one of the rest camps (lunch for own account).
DBB – privately owned lodge near Etosha Park – preferably Etosha Safari Camp

**Day 3
Mondays**

Encounter the big variety of wild life in the Park one more day. Of the 114 mammals species found in the Park, several are rare and endangered like the black rhino of the black faced impala. Your guide will also introduce you to the complex subject of managing such an enormous reserve. Lunch stop at one of the rest camps (lunch for own account).
DBB - preferably Rest camp inside the Etosha National Park; alternatively privately owned lodge near the Park

**Day 4
Tuesdays**

Depart the Rest camp or Lodge and travel south towards Otjiwarongo. Opportunity to join the group en route to Victoria Falls. Continue towards Windhoek via Okahandja where we will visit a local handicraft market. Tour ends on arrival in Windhoek late afternoon.

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This Tour is available in two different variations:

NSA005 **from/to Windhoek** on Wednesday and Saturday

NSA006 **from Swakopmund to Windhoek** on Saturday.

The Swakopmund departure includes a shuttle transfer from Swakopmund to Okahandja to join the group departing from Windhoek.
