Day 01

Windhoek – Etosha National Park

At 08:45 you will depart from Windhoek to the North. Drive via Okahandja, the former tribal centre of the Herero people, Otjiwarongo and Outjo to the famous Etosha National Park. You can enjoy your first game-viewing drive on your way to your overnight accommodation. Accommodation: Okaukuejo Camp including: Dinner and Breakfast

Day 02

Etosha National Park

Today you will have a full day of game-viewing in the Etosha National Park which is one of the major sanctuaries of wildlife in Africa. The area was proclaimed a game reserve as far back as 1907. The size of the park is 22270km² and it consists mainly of grass and bush savannah. This type of landscape provides excellent opportunities for game-viewing at the numerous waterholes or in the open countryside. The Etosha Pan which the park is named

Day 03

Etosha National Park – Tsumeb

Enjoy another game-viewing day that will be spent in the Etosha National Park. You might encounter other types of wildlife that you have not yet encountered in the other side of the Etosha National Park. Late this afternoon you will you leave the park and continue to a Lodge outside the Park.

Day 04

Tsumeb – Otjiwarongo

After breakfast you will drive to Tsumeb and visit the Mine Museum. This museum of Tsumeb's local history will inform you about the wonder world of minerals and crystals. Then Proceed via Otjiwarongo to the Mount Etjo Safari Lodge, in the late afternoon you will embark on a game drive

Accommodation: Mount Etjo Safari Lodge, Including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 05

Otjiwarongo – Windhoek

After breakfast you will return to Windhoek via Okahandja. Visit the woodcarver's market, the graves of the great Herero chiefs and the old cemetery with graves of members of the German "Schutztruppe". End of your tour.
