Day 1 & 2, Friday & Saturday

Windhoek - Swakopmund

Today you will be met by the guide at your establishment in Windhoek and transferred to Swakopmund. Upon your arrival in the early afternoon you will check into your overnight hotel, after which you will have the rest of the day to your own disposal. In the evening you can enjoy dinner at one of the many restaurants that Swakopmund has to offer. On the second day you will participate in a Champaign and oyster boat cruise in Walvis Bay.

Day 3, Sunday

Swakopmund - Damaraland

After breakfast travel along huge lichen fields to Cape Cross, a fur seal reserve where at times over 80'000 animals frolic in the waves of the Atlantic!. Drive via the Brandberg, Namibia's highest mountain (2579m), into the Damaraland, one of the least populated and geologically diverse areas in Africa. This harsh, rocky environment is home to the rare Desert Elephant, the Black Rhino and an array of free-roaming antelope species.

Accommodation: Vingerklip Lodge, Including Breakfast and Dinner

Day 4, Monday

Damaraland – Etosha

Start the morning with a visit to Twyfelfontein, a heritage site where bushman communities engraved and painted over 2500 pictures some 6000 years ago! Close by explore the Burnt Mountain, Organ Pipes and the Petrified Forest - all geological phenomena depicting the creation and evolution of some of the oldest landmasses on earth. You will also visit the Welwitschia mirabilis plant – the oldest living desert plant on earth! After a visit to a traditional Damara village proceed on to your overnight lodge situated close to the world-renowned Etosha National Park, and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Accommodation: Epacha Game Lodge & Spa, Including Breakfast and Dinner

Day 5, Tuesday

Etosha National Park

The day is devoted purely to the abundant wildlife found in the Etosha National Park, which surrounds a parched salt desert known as the Etosha Pan. The park is home to 4 of the Big Five - Elephant, Lion, Leopard and Rhino – its waterholes supporting a rich diversity of birds and mammals, including rare species such as black-faced Impala, roan, cheetah, and Namibia's smallest antelope, the Damara Dik-Dik.

Day 6, Wednesday

Etosha National Park

Today you will partake in a game drive in the Etosha National Park. You may encounter animal species you have not seen the previous day and look forward to any new surprises at the different waterholes visited.

Accommodation: Namutoni Camp, Included Breakfast and Dinner

Day 6, Thursday

Etosha National Park – Windhoek

After breakfast continue southwards to Windhoek via Okahandja where you can visit the craft markets in the main street of the capital city, there after you will be driven to your hotel or to the international airport for your return flight.
