ITINERARY:



Day 1

Windhoek – Gobabis

Depart from Windhoek in the morning at around 07:45 and drive via Witvlei and Gobabis to Kalahari Bush Breaks Guest farm 26 km away from the Buitepos / Mamuno border post. In the afternoon you partake on a game drive on the farm. After a short rest dinner will be

Accommodation: Kalahari Bush Breaks, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 2

Gobabis - Ghanzi

Early today you will depart from Kalahari Bush Breaks. After the border post procedures, the drive will continue via Tshootsha (formerly Kalkfontein) and Ghanzi to D'kar. From here you will be transferred to Grassland Bushman Lodge some 70 km northeast of Ghanzi. In the afternoon a Bushmen trail will take place. Dinner will be served, whilst watching traditional Bushmen dances.

Accommodation: Grassland Bushman Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 3

Ghanzi

This day is spent on Grassland Bushman Lodge. In the early morning you will embark on a beautiful game-viewing drive. The afternoon you will spend at leisure. At your own costs, you can take part in several activities which are offered by the lodge.

Accommodation: Grassland Bushman Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 4

Ghanzi – Maun

In the morning return transfer to D'kar and afterwards continue to Maun via Kuke Gate and Toteng. In the afternoon there is sufficient time available for a scenic flight over the Okavango delta. (We offer this flight optional).

Accommodation: Maun Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 5

Maun - Nata

After breakfast drive via Motopi and past the Nxai Pan Park, Makgadikgadi Pans National Park and Gweta to Nata. After lunch you will have time to relax. In the afternoon 4x4 vehicles will take the group to the nearby area for a nature drive.

Accommodation: Nata Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 6

Nata – Chobe National Park

After breakfast the tour will proceed northwards through the Sibuyu Forest Reserve, the Kazuma Forest Reserve and the Kasane Forest Reserve Extension to Kasane. After lunch (not included) time to relax, and in the afternoon you will be taken on a boat trip on the Chobe river in the Chobe National Park.

Accommodation: Chobe Safari Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 7

Chobe National Park

Today, very early you will be taken in 4x4 vehicles into the Chobe National Park for stunning Game Viewing. In the afternoon, a boat trip on the Chobe.

Accommodation: Chobe Safari Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 8

Chobe National Park – Victoria Falls

Drive via Kazungula border post to Victoria Falls. Visit to the Victoria Falls and a short city tour, after which you will be dropped off at the hotel.

Accommodation: A'Zambezi River Lodge, including Breakfast

Day 9

Victoria Falls

This day is devoted to you and can spend the day at leisure and partake in optional activities offered by the lodge.

Accommodation: A'Zambezi River Lodge, including Breakfast

Day 10

Victoria falls – Kongola

Drive from Victoria Falls via Kasane, Ngoma Bridge, Katima Mulilo and Kongolato Namushasha Lodge. Later this afternoon you can enjoy a sundowner boat-trip on the Kwando river.

Accommodation: Namushasha Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 11

Bwabwata National Park

In the morning you'll have time to spend at leisure. In the afternoon board a boat to cross the Kwando River, where an open4x4 game drive vehicle awaits you inside Bwabwata National Park, the largest park in the Caprivi Strip. The game drive is ended with a short return trip by boat to the lodge.

Accommodation: Namushasha Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 12

Kongola - Bagani

Your journey continues via Kongola and Bagani to the Mahangu Safari Lodge. The rest of the Afternoon you can spend at leisure.

Accommodation: Mahangu Safari Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 13

Mahangu National Park

Today you have an excursion into the Mahangu National Park by safari vehicle.

Accommodation: Mahangu Safari Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 14

Bagani - Rundu

Visit the Popa Falls and proceed to the Kaisosi River Lodge near Rundu.

You will arrive around lunchtime. Later this afternoon you embark on a boat-trip on the Kavango River. (This trip will depend on the Water level of the Kavango River).

Accommodation: Kaisosi River Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 15

Rundu - Otavi

Drive via Rundu and Grootfontein to the Hoba Meteorite. After visit continue to the Ohange Safari Lodge in the Otavi Mountains. Late this afternoon you will enjoy a sun-downer drive on the farm.

Accommodation: Ohange Safari Lodge, including Dinner and Breakfast

Day 16

Otavi – Windhoek

Travel via Otjiwarongo to Okahandja. Visit the woodcarvers market for some souvenir shopping and proceed to Windhoek. You will arrive in the afternoon.

Services included:

*Overland trips and all sightseeing as per itinerary.

*Overnight in double rooms with private shower/bath and toilet in hotels and rest camps.

*Breakfast throughout the tour and 13 dinners.
